Dear Parent/Carer,

Guilsborough Sixth Form are planning a trip to Go Ape based at Coombe Abbey in Coventry for the new Year 12 students. We have organised team building trips for the past few years, and it has been hugely beneficial for the students in getting to know each other better and helping to develop their teamwork and communication skills. We are encouraging the whole of Year 12 to attend this trip as we think it is a fantastic opportunity. For this to happen, we will be collapsing the Y12 curriculum. Any students who choose not to attend this trip will be expected to be in school, undertaking supervised study with Miss Ritchie in S8.

The cost of the trip will include: -

- 1. Return coach travel to and from Coombe Abbey, Coventry. We are aiming to leave school at 9am and return at 4.30pm.
- 2. Participation in the land-based problem-solving game Baboonzled.
- 3. Tree Top Challenge high ropes experience. Students who do not wish to take part in this can pay the reduced fee and cheer their friends on from the ground.

Spending money will be needed to purchase drinks during the day; we advise all students to bring a packed lunch as there are minimal food services on site.

If you would like your child to attend this trip, please complete and return the attached reply slip and behaviour contract to Miss Fairlie in Sixth Form by 20th July 2023. The fee must also be paid via ParentPay by this date. If your child does not enrol at Guilsborough Sixth Form, you will need to keep your parent pay account open until 4<sup>th</sup> September in order for us to process your refund.
