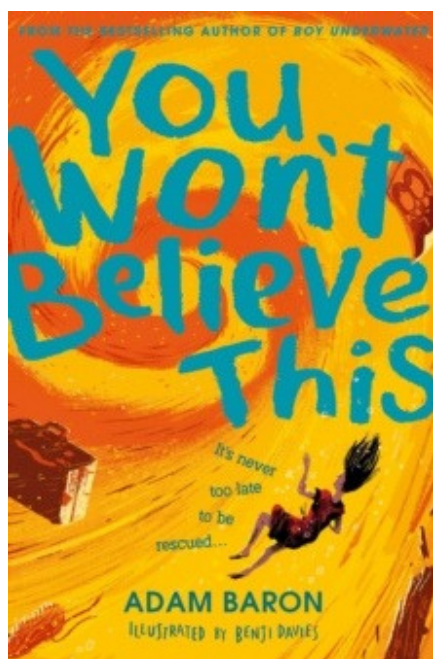


WHY READ DURING THE SUMMER?

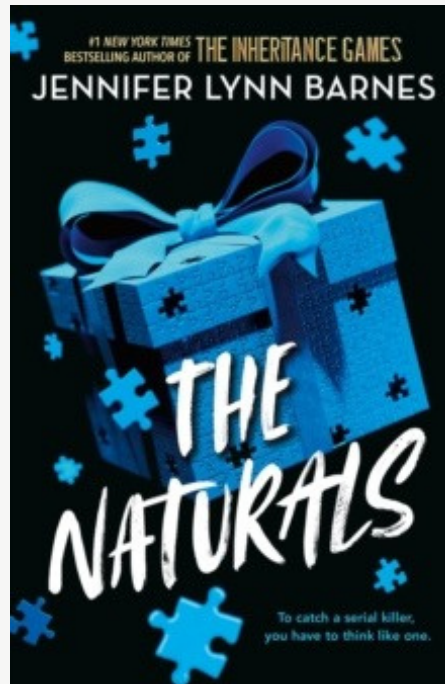
Scythe by Neal Shusterman
