Guilsborough Academy is striving for musical excellence

All students are encouraged and supported in whatever musical activity they participate in, whether that is in the classroom or during extra curricular activities. We seek to provide an exciting, challenging and enjoyable education.

Instrumental and vocal tuition charging policy

At present this policy:

- Offers subsidised tuition for all students receiving lessons from the Northamptonshire Music and Performing Arts Trust - from September 2021 the charge is £70.00 per term, or £210.00 for the whole year.
- Offers reduced fees to families who are currently eligible or have been entitled to Free School Meals in the past six years or are entitled to Pupil Premium

Conditions of receiving lessons:

- Students are expected to attend at least one extra curricular musical activity during the week
- Students are expected to practice regularly and attend their instrumental lessons
- Notice period is a full term (11
 weeks) and must be given in writing
 to Miss McFall, reception if a student
 wishes to cease their tuition
- A deposit of one term's fees (£70.00) is payable when application is made in May prior to the start of the academic year

Scheme for the purchase of musical instruments

This scheme enables parents to purchase instruments free from VAT. The purchase has to be made through Guilsborough Academy. If you are interested, please contact us for further details.



When do the lessons take place?

Instrumental lessons take place during the school day and, where possible, are run on a rota system timetable.

Where do the lessons take place?

All lessons are given in the music department.

How will students know when their lesson is?

The timetables for each instrumental teacher are displayed on the noticeboard in the music department.

Is there anywhere students can store their instrument?

There is an instrumental storeroom within the department where students can leave their instruments.

What do students do if they miss their lesson?

Try to speak to their instrumental teacher to arrange another time in the day, or speak to one of the music teachers, or Miss McFall in reception.

Is insurance needed?

Parents are responsible for ensuring that all instruments, including those on loan through the Northamptonshire Music and Performing Arts Trust, are covered for loss or theft etc. under appropriate insurance.

How do I apply?

FEES

Term One

A payment of £70.00 is required with the music lesson application form.

Term Two

A second payment of £70.00 will be invoiced at the beginning of October 2021.

Term Three

A third payment of £70.00 will be invoiced at the beginning of February 2022.

If you wish, you can pay £210.00 to cover the whole year. A term is 11 lessons of 10 minutes or 20 minute group lesson of no more than 2 students.

ParentPay should be used as a preferred method of payment for terms two and three. Further information will follow with your activation code.
