OUT OF CATCHMENT TRANSPORT

Parents are reminded that if they live outside the normal school catchment area, they are responsible for transport for their children and whilst the school endeavours to assist in this area, it is under no obligation to do so and cannot guarantee that current additional bus services will continue in future years.

Brixworth and Kingsthorpe (Welford Road Only) and Daventry

The Brixworth, Kingsthorpe and Daventry areas fall outside the contracted bus routes managed by the County Council and therefore parents of out of catchment students remain responsible for arranging transport for their children.

Hamiltons have provided three coaches which covers the Brixworth, Kingsthorpe and Daventry routes. Pick up times are set out at; www.hamiltons-coaches.co.uk/nsg-coach-services

The Brixworth bus stops in Lamport and Hanging Houghton prior to travelling onto Brixworth.

The Kingsthorpe bus starts at the Bus Interchange and comes into Kingsthorpe on the A508 Harborough Road, then turns and picks up on the Welford Road and goes along the A5199 to Guilsborough, also picking up in Chapel Brampton.

The Daventry coach picks up from Middlemore, Drayton Fields, Drayton, Ashby Fields, Lang Farm and Welton.

In order for the route to be viable for the bus contractor, the cost for these services is £4 per day return, £3 per day single for Brixworth and Kingsthorpe, and for Daventry the cost is £4.50 per day return or £3.50 per day single.

All students are expected to adhere to the Northamptonshire County Council Code of Conduct. In the event of any unacceptable behaviour on the coach, the driver will report this to the coach operator and the school and steps will be taken to deal with the matter which may involve banning the relevant student from travelling on the coach.

Non-Entitled Students Travel Scheme

A concessionary bus pass is one which is allocated by the County Council to a student who lives outside the catchment area for a place on a bus which picks up from within the catchment area.

This is only issued if there is spare capacity on the appropriate bus and now costs £1000 per year.

Bus numbers are not finalised for a couple of weeks into the autumn term as sixth formers are entitled to places before out of catchment students.

HOME TO SCHOOL TRANSPORT EXPECTATIONS



RULES

- Students will carry their bus pass and show the driver their authorisation to travel.
- Failure to do so renders them to be refused travel.
- Pupils have all been issued a pass for a specific route and vehicle. This is to ensure that students' safety is conveyed by loading the vehicles to agreed levels. In the unfortunate event of an accident we need to be sure which students are on each vehicle.
- If there is an important reason why a student should need to travel on a different bus, please refer your request by email so that it can be dealt with accordingly. Email: SchoolTransport.NCC@westnorthants.gov.uk

TEMPORARY BUS PASSES

- For students travelling on contracted vehicles, schools may issue a temporary pass for a **maximum of 5 days**, whilst the pupil is obtaining a duplicate pass. A maximum of 3 temporary passes can be issued to a student.

STUDENT PASSES

- If a student loses their pass, a replacement will need to be purchased. Please visit www.westnorthants.gov.uk to apply for an immediate replacement. **The charge is £25.00 by credit/debit card.**

PLEASE NOTE

Students are only permitted to travel on the bus service they are allocated to. Temporary passes CANNOT be issued for other bus routes without prior consent from Northampton County Council Mainstream Transport (01604 526431).
