Essential Requirements		
Safety & Identification	Student ID/Lanyard: Must be worn visibly at all times for security and safeguarding purposes	
General Standards	All clothing must be clean, well-maintained, and appropriate for an educational environment - Clothing should be modest and respectful of our diverse community - Items should be free from offensive language, imagery or inappropriate content	
Clothing Guidelines	Acceptable	Not Permitted
Lower Body	- Full length chinos and formal trousers (smart casual) - Tailored shorts (mid-thigh or below) - Skirts and dresses (mid-thigh or below)	- Leggings as standalone bottoms - Extremely short skirts/shorts (above mid-thigh) - Ripped or distressed clothing - Sportswear or joggers - Cargo or utility pants - Denim or leather
Upper Body	- Collared shirts and blouses - Smart casual tops with sleeves (covering shoulders) - Knitwear (jumpers, cardigans) - Polo shirts - Plain T shirts (no logo larger than 2cm)	- Crop tops or midriff-revealing clothing - Strapless or spaghetti strap tops - Hooded sweatshirts - Clothing with large logos or slogans - Transparent or sheer fabrics - Oversized / sports t shirts
Footwear	- Smart casual shoes or boots - Canvas shoes in block or neutral colours (converse, vans, adidas etc) - Loafers and dress shoes - Small heeled smart shoes	- Flip-flops or sliders - Backless footwear - Bright or neon-coloured trainers - Crocs, Ugg boots etc or similar casual footwear - Heels you cannot walk in comfortably!
Additional Guidelines		
Professional Appearance	- Hair should be neat and well-groomed - Tattoos are appropriate, and may be asked to be covered - Piercings should be modest and safe for the learning environment	
Outerwear	Blazers/Jackets: Encouraged for a professional appearance Coats: Must be removed during lessons Hoodies: Are not permitted	
Seasonal Considerations	Summer: Lightweight fabrics acceptable, but coverage standards remain Winter: Layering encouraged while maintaining professional appearance
