

We have also created a dedicated sixth form website area, which you will find as you enter the website, containing information for current and prospective students about our sixth form. Our aim is that our website becomes a powerful tool and central point of contact for all our stakeholders. One aspect of the new website we are particularly proud of is the stunning photography and videography that is featured throughout.

The website will 'go live' this week and you will be able to access it through our usual www.guilsborough.northants.sch.uk address. However, due to the fact we are using the same web address, users who have already accessed our website will need to clear the cache on whichever device they are using. This is required as cookies downloaded to your device, which enable you to interact with our current website, may interfere with the new one. Fortunately, clearing the cache is a relatively straightforward process.

The instructions are slightly different depending on the browser you are using. For Google Chrome, the following instructions apply:

- Select the three dots at the top of the screen



- Click on 'History'
- Select 'Clear browsing data' on the left hand side (Google Chrome). Other browsers show this in a slightly different place.

- Change the time range to all time then confirm. Please note, some websites may load slightly slower the first time they are visited but this will resolve itself very quickly.
