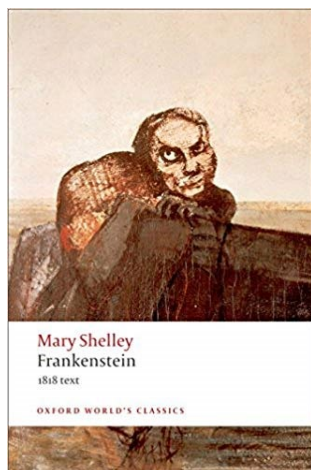
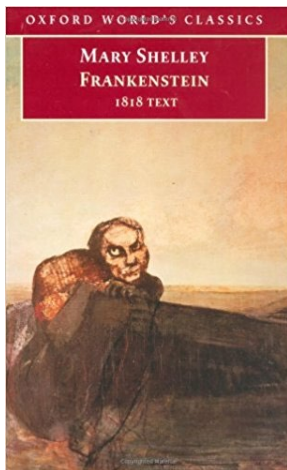


**ELLA: Books you will need to buy and which versions**
