## **Films**

**The Big Short (2015)** – The Big Short is a 2015 American biographical crime comedy-drama film directed and co-written by Adam McKay. Co-written by Charles Randolph, it is based on the 2010 book *The Big Short: Inside the Doomsday Machine* by Michael Lewis showing how the 2007–2008 financial crisis was triggered by the United States housing bubble.

**Margin Call (2011)** – Margin Call is a 2011 American drama film written and directed by J. C. Chandor in his feature directorial debut. The principal story takes place over a 24-hour period at a large Wall Street investment bank during the initial stages of the 2007–2008 financial crisis. In focus are the actions taken by a group of employees during the subsequent financial collapse. The title comes from a finance term for when an investor must increase the securities or other assets used as collateral for a loan when their value falls below a certain threshold.

**Rogue Trader (1999)** – The film centres on the life of former derivatives broker [Nick Leeson](#) and the 1995 collapse of [Barings Bank](#).

**Boiler Room (2000)** – A college dropout, attempting to live up to his father's high standards, gets a job as a broker for a suburban investment firm which puts him on the fast track to success. But the job might not be as legitimate as it first appeared to be.

**Wall Street (1987)** – The film tells the story of Bud Fox, a young [stockbroker](#) who becomes involved with [Gordon Gekko](#), a wealthy, unscrupulous [corporate raider](#).

**Enron: The Smartest Guys in the Room (2005)** – A 2005 American [documentary film](#) based on the best-selling 2003 [book of the same name](#) by *Fortune* reporters [Bethany McLean](#) and Peter Elkind, who are credited as writers of the film alongside the director, [Alex Gibney](#). It examines the 2001 collapse of the [Enron Corporation](#), which resulted in criminal trials for several of the company's top executives during the ensuing [Enron scandal](#), and contains a section about the involvement of Enron traders in the [2000-01 California electricity crisis](#). [Archival footage](#) is used alongside new interviews with McLean and Elkind, several former Enron executives and employees, stock analysts, reporters, and former [Governor of California Gray Davis](#).



**Inside Job (2010)** – A 2010 American [documentary film](#), directed by [Charles Ferguson](#), about the [late-2000s financial crisis](#). Ferguson, who began researching in 2008,<sup>[3]</sup> said the film is about "the systemic corruption of the United States by the [financial services](#) industry and the consequences of that systemic corruption",<sup>[4]</sup> amongst them conflicts of interest of academic research, which led to improved disclosure standards by the [American Economic Association](#).<sup>[5]</sup> In five parts, the film explores how changes in the policy environment and banking practices helped create the financial crisis.
